The Book of Jeremiah

The prophet Jeremiah ministers during the last but tumultuous years of the Southern Kingdom of Judah. He does not mince his words but speaks of the nation's failure to keep and obey God's covenant. His message is one of national and personal repentance in which failure to do so will invite God's judgment in the form of foreign invasion and exile. His words thus stand in conflict with those of the nation's political and religious leaders who advocate making political alliances with Egypt and continuing to hide behind the doctrine of Zion's inviolability. For prophesying a contradictory word, Jeremiah suffers great persecution. However, he is not totally alone, and a small circle of friends and supporters stands with him. This course will examine the prophetic book of Jeremiah by attending to the historical, literary, and theological backgrounds. It will seek to go behind the book's portrayal of the prophet to see the man and his message. We will focus on a few key texts for exegesis and draw out valuable lessons on how the book can continue to address the Christian Church living in similar tumultuous times in Malaysia.

DR. ANTHONY LOKE is currently an independent researcher, author, lecturer, and preacher. He is currently an adjunct lecturer with BCM, AOIC, SPTC, and JBCM. He served 32 years as an ordained minister with the Trinity Annual Conference of the Methodist Church in Malaysia, and 19 years as a full-time lecturer in the Old Testament in Seminari Theoloji Malaysia. He completed his PhD in Old Testament from the University of Wales, UK, in 2011. He has authored 13 books and continues to write in "The Old Testament Made Simple" series.
