DEDICATION & EDITORIAL



Dedication to REV. ENOCH TAN

In 1973, Rev. Enoch Tan graduated from Bible College of Malaysia (then known as the Bible Institute of Malaysia). He has been mightily used by God in many pioneering works. An exemplary disciple of Christ, the Holy Spirit infused within him a great evangelistic vision, mission, passion and boldness in preaching the Gospel and Bible. His work has seen millions of lives being saved and transformed by God.

Rev. Enoch pioneered several churches in the 1970s, from Faith Assembly in Segambut to Bethel Assembly, in Sungai Petani. He was also instrumental in starting the Chinese Department of BCM in the early 1980s. In the first three years, he was the only full time Chinese department lecturer teaching all subjects. In 1982, the Spirit of God called him to evangelize Malaysia. In obedience, he launched "Every Home for Christ" in Malaysia, preaching the Gospel to every home. He travelled from town to town, state to state, until he covered our whole country twice! More than forty five thousand people responded and became Christians.

In 1987, Rev. Enoch launched "Every Home for Christ" in China, and pioneered the printing of bibles, books, and gospel tracts for house churches, and house-to-house evangelism. His evangelistic ministry blazed the trail into many provinces throughout China and he saw millions of lives profess the Name of Jesus! For the past 27 years, he has been faithfully preaching the gospel, doing power ministry, teaching God's Word, and raising thousands of leaders in bible schools. He has witnessed many healings and miracles – blind eyes being opened, deaf ears being unlocked – and he has even escaped life-threatening situations by the grace of God.

He has also served as the director for Living Bible International, International Bible Society in Malaysia, and CEIFA International Ministry for China. Additionally, in his faith and trust in God, he was propelled by the Spirit of God to be His mouthpiece as an international speaker.

After passing the baton to the younger leaders in China, Rev. Enoch, now 68, has now returned to Kuala Lumpur. He continues to be their advisor and is a much sought after itinerant speaker.

Rev. Enoch has lived his life loving and telling the story of Jesus. His love and passion in winning souls for Christ continues to burn, and he loves to raise young preachers of the Gospel truth! What an immense joy and honour it is for us to dedicate this year's KEY to Rev. Enoch Tan, whom God has truly used as His Catalyst near and far! Rev. Enoch's heartfelt message to the graduates is, "Obey the Word of God. Take the Word of God to mould your character to be like Jesus."

陈赞发牧师是马来西亚圣经学院（前称马来亚神召神学院，BIM）1973年的毕业生。在多处的开荒工作上，陈牧师被上帝极大的使用。他是基督门徒之典范。圣灵赐给了他传福音的异象、使命、热忱和勇气，把福音带到他所去过的地方。其服事使数以万计的生命得到救恩，且被神大大的改变。

在1970年代，就在陈牧师在神学院学习的最后一年，他开荒了多间教会：从泗岩末的信心神召会，至双溪大年的伯特利神召会。1980年代初，正在他开拓教会的年日里，他也开始了马来西亚圣经学院中文部的事工。陈牧师是当时神学院里唯一的中文教师，需要教导几乎所有的中文科目。在1982年，圣灵呼召他专注在马来西亚宣教。于是，陈牧师带着顺服的心，于1983年在马来西亚开拓了“逐家文字佈道会”事工，把福音带进每一个家园。他曾经两次巡回全马各城各乡，成功带领4万5千人信主。

在1987年，上帝扩张陈牧师的事奉境界，带领他到中国传福音，把“逐家文字佈道会”事工带到中国，并开始大量印刷圣经、书籍以及福音单张，逐家文字佈道事工使用。他的工作为中国许多省份的佈道事工开拓了一条崭新的道路，同时也看到了数百万人的生命信耶稣的名字！过去27年来，陈牧师一直忠实地传福音，带领满有能力的事工，教导神的话语，并透过圣经学校而兴起数以千计的领袖。他曾见证许多的医治和神迹：瞎眼得看见、耳聋得听见，在极度危险的情况下经历神奇妙的保守。另外，陈牧师亦曾担任Living Bible International的董事、International Bible Society in Malaysia的董事，并CEIFA International Ministry for China的董事。凭着对神的信心，加上圣灵的工作，陈牧师亦是国际讲员，足迹遍布英国、美国、加拿大、日本、南太平洋、欧洲及东亚地区。

随着年纪的增长，陈牧师现今已68岁，并从中国返回吉隆坡。去年，他也把棒子交给中国当地的年轻领袖，并继续成为他们的顾问。现在，他亦经常被邀请到各地传讲神的话语。在过去的半个世纪里，陈牧师热爱耶稣并不停地宣讲耶稣的事迹。他为基督赢取灵魂的热情仍然不停地燃烧着，而且热忱于兴起那些传讲福音的年轻传道人！我们是何等的喜悦和荣幸，能够把今年的校刊献给陈赞发牧师，一位被神使用并充分发挥催化转变影响力的牧者。陈牧师给予毕业生衷心的忠告是：顺服神的话语，以神的话语来塑造你，使你更像耶稣。

Dear Graduates,

On behalf of the faculty, staff and students, our heartfelt congratulations upon your graduation! May the Lord continue to lead, guide and bless you as you go forth into the ministry field to do His work.

It is been our joy and privilege to be instrumental in your training for the ministry. We hope and pray that we have given you strong and firm foundations for life and ministry. May your days be filled with good memories of the "place that is dear to me." We trust that you will not forget the many lessons learnt, formally and informally, in and out of the classroom, the sense of the Spirit in the chapel services and during the times of your personal and group devotions, the ministry opportunities at the local church during the weekends as well as with other students in the ministry teams to elaborate other than your own.

The theme chosen for this year's KEY magazine and graduation is "**Catalysts – His Spirit Our Significance**." Two texts underpinned the theme: one from the Old Testament, "Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit," says the LORD Almighty" (Zechariah 4:6 NRSV); and one from the New Testament, "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8 NRSV). Both texts are well-known and well-loved by Christians, and certainly, it is most appropriate that you graduates be reminded of the source of your power for effective ministry.

The theme's emphasis is on being catalysts. A catalyst is a person or an event that suddenly causes change or action. In that regard, the anointing of the Spirit on the disciples on the Day of Pentecost is the supreme example of a Catalyst. When the Spirit came upon the disciples, they were suddenly transformed from a little group fearing to speak of their savior (John 20:19) to ardent proclaimers and evangelists who three thousand baptised that very same day and of whom some years later were known as the people "who have turned the world upside down" (Acts 17:6 ESV).

Throughout history the great revivals that changed the church and the world have been the result of the outpouring of the same Spirit of God – that same Catalyst! And of course, the work of the Spirit has always been accomplished through men and women who have themselves been changed completely by the power of the Holy Spirit. It is in this regard that these people, more often than not rejected by the world, are the catalysts for change in the church and the world.

The training you received at BCM has given you the foundations for effective ministry. However, that is not enough. In order to be a catalyst to change the church and the world for the better, the power of the Spirit of God is absolutely essential. Without the Spirit, you cannot effect real lasting change. Do not ever forget that as you graduate and go wherever the Lord may lead you. Remember too that the Lord himself will be with you to the very end of the age. Amen.

催化恭祝本校圣餐学院第五十三届毕业生完成学业的美满。

马来西亚圣餐学院是一所以五旬节信仰为主导的圣经学校，她的使命就是在新时代带领更多神圣灵充满的传道人，不仅在讲台上的传道，更是在家庭上能帮助有能力及文物的工人，并教会他们去从事上帝伟大的修养、领导及宣教的事业。这是提供神学生个人发展、学识、才能及领导装备的最适当学习空间。

"催化转变，进而统治"是今年本学年的年刊的主题。要转化个人、家庭、社会、甚至国家不只是他的经济、政治和教育的力量，更是需要信仰的治国力。人文文明、科技进步、文化开拓或电子普及无所不能真正保证一个社会的成功。一个社会的转变也必须从个人的修养、品行的塑造和宗教的信仰着手。同样，在教会转化过程中中，除了需要人力、财力、财力及精神的准备之外，属灵的话语是不可或缺的。

长者今天教会需要什么？领袖的界象吗？有影响力的吗？精彩的节目吗？高举敬拜吗？这些元素固然重要，但若没有神的灵在教会大大的彰显，教会就无法有活力并互有能力地为生竹美好的见证。然而圣餐正在世界各地运行，并带进校园与神合作的教会，教会真地需要圣灵的工作。况且，从古至今圣灵的工作从未曾停止过。对圣餐五旬节信仰来说，圣灵的能力和恩膏是改变人生命的最大秘诀。

当圣长斯罗巴伯被神呼召到耶路撒冷时，他圣地呼喊的大人宣读圣灵工作的时候，万军之耶和华鼓励着他说：“不是你的能力，不是你的才能，乃是你的神的灵方能成事。”《耶和华耶路撒冷4:8》。生命的转化和变化有赖于圣灵的大能。因此圣长对圣灵充满的追求和圣灵的火是不可缺少的。教会发现今天教会的运作模式，相当人为的需要多过神手的恩典，多过做人的方式、才能、经历等智慧多于依赖圣灵的大能来称赞教会。在此我要强调的是，我们没有看见人的能力将胜出的重要性，更关键的是神的定仪在哪里，圣灵有空间介入许多与我们教会的经历吗？因此，教会实在是需要圣灵的恩典，以及神的转化。

根据教会造就长及社区的转化资源而言圣灵的作用，信徒的生命与服事也离不开圣灵的同在，圣灵奇妙的工作叫他们谦卑是可空见惯的榜样。反之，圣灵若没有在教会中运行或彰显，那就失去做见证的能力，因此使徒保罗在《罗马书15:18》说：“除了师傅所交给你的秘密，连什么都不知道。只是神的恩赐而已，用神的奇能作工，用神的爱作工，用圣灵的大力，使外邦人归服。”

但愿今届所有的毕业生，在生活及事奉上都能够保守得神五旬节的信仰，并培养被圣灵引领及教导，以催化个人、家庭、教会及社会内部的转化，并带来更大的属灵复兴及成长。

Pentecostal and Asian

By Rev. Dr. Mowuk Ma, an esteemed friend of SCM

We are proud Pentecostals, who witnessed the turn of a new millennium. Not many have this rare opportunity as we did. In the history of Christianity, that is just two-thousand old, there is a special awakening to us. If you are between 25 to 35 years old, you are the 'Third Christian Millennium', the very first generation since the shift of global Christianity in the early 1980s. We are also proud of our Pentecostal identity, which has changed modern Christianity to many ways; and we are proud to Asia from the largest continent in the world with a varied cultural richness and diversity, and the heart of all the world's religions.

As Christians, we are particularly grateful that we were able to witness several unprecedented achievements in ourselves. Global Christianity has increased at an unheard-of rate: from 1.13 million in 1910 to 2.282.5 million in 2010, a growth by 2.7% alone. In the same period, African Christianity grew more than 40-fold from a mere 11.7 million to 484.7 million! In the midst of this staggering growth are Pentecostal and Pentecostal-like forms of Christianity. Perhaps the most creative and flexible Christian movement throughout its history. In the last century, it has evolved into myriad forms and shapes, actively interacting with its given socio-religious contexts. African Independent Churches and Chinese Christianity are but two largely identifiable forms of this evolution.

But this glorious ascent of growth comes with a deep valley, particularly from two realities. First, the impressive growth of Christianity especially in the global south has been practically uncoupled set by the growth of the general population and that of other religions. The net proportion of world Christians against the population has shrunk from 34.8% to 23.2% in the same period. Second, Asia, the most populous continent with more than half of the world's population, still remains under 10%, less than 1/3 of the world average.

That is exactly why we focus our study as Pentecostals and Asians, that on Pentecostals. There are several key features that make this form of Christianity stand out from the rest. It has been the main engine of Christian growth globally and its heart is close to the worldviews of the global South. It also brought the long-neglected creative dimension of religious life. After all, it is closer to the very form of Christianity than most of the others. Now, many new Christians have understood this. For example, it is estimated that more than half of Asian Christians are Pentecostal or Pentecostal-like in their beliefs and practices. And this movement does not show any sign of slowing, as it creatively adapts to new contexts and the creativity of the Holy Spirit leads God's people to new horizons of spiritual experiences. He loves to surprise us!

Secondly, on Asia. Yes, it is remarkable in a series, along with Western Europe, for the slowing of the growth of global Christianity, thus a call for the "church-down" phenomenon. But this also invites the judgment and its church (like you and me) the focus of the next era of the expansion of global Christianity. What are some recommendations? This conference is the heart of all the major global religions, and Christianity. In both its long and short histories, has been deeply integrated with (and sometimes blurring) many those lines. In fact, Christian brothers and sisters are persecuted and martyred in every parts of this continent. This issue is close to that of the early church. While this makes Asia the most challenging mission field, its Christians are intentionally prepared to live, work and witness in such a challenging social environment. Malaysia is an exact example of it. Also, Asian churches have become increasingly missionary, especially in recent decades. This missionarity

experience is a special gift of the Spirit. And often this takes place in spite of, or because of, harsh social environments, be it persecution or poverty. It has also experienced revivals as a continuing trend, although in different places at different times. How about the spread of Asians all over the world? If the heart of people is an integral part of God's strategy for the expansion of His rule, Malaysian Christians with Chinese, Indian and Indigenous origins are a clear sign of God's plan. For example, I can see why Chinese congregations in the West prefer Malaysian Chinese pastor who can speak one or two Chinese dialects and English. It's more than a matter of language & cultural growing and exposure, and this list can go on.

Put these two together: Pentecostal and Asia. We can now see the future of global Christianity and its mission. And that's great.

Then what does it require for you (and me) to be this special generation of enlightened? First, take the Holy Spirit in His fullness. Let Him possess you, rather than you using Him. Let His thoughts be yours, and His desire yours. Secondly, while relying on His wisdom and power in the fullest sense, match it with your own responsibilities. In prayer, in study, and in work. Third, let the Spirit take you to understand yourself. Are you praying in tongue, for example, because we have done it for years? Or, do we pray in tongue to experience a fresh presence of the Spirit? Do we desire the way He will work in and through us? Life in the Spirit is anything but dull. However can be exciting but also unpredictable. But that's exactly what the Spirit loves to do. Lastly, embrace the world as the Spirit sees it. If Jesus loves the world, so does the Spirit. In fact, He will cause us to weep for the world that is suffering in violence and injustice without hope.

And, walk with the Spirit confidently as a chosen generation: Pentecostal and Asian. But also commit to preparing yourself for the task. May the Spirit use you in order for global Christianity to grow over the 1/3 soil of the world's population, for the first time in its history, except for a short time two hundred years ago.

五旬宗与亚洲人

对于我们而言，能被说是一个千禧年的新手是一件很光耀的事情。然而我们已经经历了两千年的历史，真的是又老又平凡。如果你的年龄介于25至35岁之间，那么你是在基督教历史里“第三个千禧年”；而且你也是自1980年之后一代世纪以来基督教增长最快的。我们也为着我们是五旬宗信徒这个身份很感到骄傲，五旬节运动在现代基督教许多领域上都是最大的派别；不仅如此，我们也为身为更高的人而感到自豪—世界最大的大洲，这个大洲包含了许许多多不同的文化，更是世界主要宗教的摇篮之一。

身为基督徒，你会发现这是我们在过去近20个世纪历史上史无前例的成就。全球基督徒达到了前所未有的增长：从1910只有613,000,000位信徒，一跃到2010年我们有2,282,500,000位基督徒，增长了3.75倍。这期间，全球基督徒数量更是超过了42倍的增长，从最初的11,700,000位基督徒增长到了4,700,000,000位信徒！其中五旬节教会占了这个数字的绝大部分就是华人！这两个事实都表明在上个世纪的历史上是一个非常有趣的现象有神的恩典赐予我们，在不同的地方，有着不同的生活方式，积极地把神福音本土化。这样的改革浪潮要在以前的对立教会，并令人震惊地可以和谐地看到。

因此我们预言将很快有更多人的成长，但愿我们少不要忘记了其重要性，尤其是在下面两个世界性现象。第一，信徒的平均年龄，但是世界人口的平均年龄比基督徒高了整整10岁。在得救之前，基督徒世界人口的比例以34.8%占比的小数点2.2%分之。第二，占全球半数以上世界人口的亚洲，少过10%占比基督教，在世界基督教的比例少过三分之一。

这就是为什么我们那么迫切地希望我们是耶稣基督的拿撒勒人。第一，从豆蔻年华开始，以下的四点让这个豆蔻年华的你一帆风顺：在信徒的平均年龄上，五旬节教会是尤其地以身心为特色。除此之外，五旬节教会的平均之世界观更为亲近，五旬节教会的信徒对永生达的热切内心，没有话说。五旬节模式比其他宗教更容易和最完全地认识。如今，许多基督教徒仍然认为生命的真谛是义。比如说，是以一种更宽泛的神学概念在五旬节教会人心中获得的教会品。而这个活生生的基督教信仰下水的结果，反而证明了更多的本土特色，还有加上不列颠的特征，帮助他们更快地在湖面上进入一个新的领域。他们的确做了很多的准备！

第二，新崛起的广袤大陆。虽然新的教会正在快速增长，但信徒增长的速度，仍然是远远不及世界“教会增长放缓”的主要原因之一。但愿让亚洲及其教会负起应有的责任，把重点放在下一个千年全球教会的扩展！虽然不好盼归宿，但也有希望让它们得救的地方。上文提到，就是全世界主要宗教—基督教的诞生地，基督教在亚洲的历史上，都与这个大陆有关。（感谢内院）事实上，更重要的是在各方面上提升了许多的日本，更有许多基督教福音传播的区域。这个福音使耶稣成为了一个真正的统治者福音工场，把福音传播的装备在大片的荒漠地带土地上生长、工作并且成为福音之见证人。马尔的兄弟就是一个新生的基督孩子。此外，基督教福音教会开启了许多社会经济的领域，包括政治和商业的领域。但是，我们却不得不落后了。原因，无论是在政治、商业、宗教、家庭这些方面在世界上都是领先的。如果人口的增长率上上帝计划中的一部分，为的是扩展基督教的国度，那么马来西亚就是基督福音传播的希望所在！上帝的计划，我们可以看见为数百万的中文机会做好一位说书大侠—同时也是大马李青的梦想。基督教文化的因素可能们能更好的理解之和享受过大马丰富的文化遗产！

把两个元素放在一起：亚洲的信仰实践人。我们可以完全地相信你将有你的宗教光明的未来。而这个未来的掌握在你们—有使命的实践人手中！

第三，身为一位属于神的年代的基督教领袖上什么代价？第一，全然的神的实现。让雅各完全地有，不是你吸引得实现。让谦卑的心成为我们的核心，让不惑的智慧成为我们的灵魂。第二，我们不仅要完全地神的智慧与能力，我们也要作好充足的准备，无论是在神像上，在学业上扎实工作上。第三，让圣灵带领我们进入神的领域。比如说，我们配得上圣洁只是例行公事而已，还是我们真正渴望追求的一个对圣洁的更深认识？我们是否得常常在我们的一生中，用不同的方式向我们做工！活在荣耀中你将得着的，你的事情是外在的，但也会带来生命不舒适。但，这并不是真实的盼望。诚然，用圣洁的眼光来审视世界。如果耶稣是世人，圣洁也同样是世人。事实上，他会让我们为着所领受的真理受苦。暴力冲突和没有智慧的属灵争斗。

总结来说，身为被拣选的时代，有你心地与圣灵同行；身在五旬节信仰的见证人。但愿我们能够并准备好完成我们的工作。同时期待你在未来的教会增长上有份，古老的传教区内，基督教史上神曾使第一次跨过三分之一起过世界人口比例的地球上。

In the 1960's (when I was a young boy) there were 10 million Pentecostals worldwide. Now the number of Pentecostals has reached over 300 million. Chesty Matemba, the African Man, describes this movement as the strongest force within Christianity.

The Assemblies of God, the largest organization within that Pentecostal movement, celebrated her Centennial, one-hundred year birthday this past August. From an insignificant colony of hungry believers, projections are that by 2020 there will be 100 million in the Assemblies of God worldwide. Even now, a church is being planted by the Assemblies of God every 45 minutes. Over 2000 AG Missions schools are training workers worldwide for the harvest.

The Holy Spirit has changed the whole picture of the harvest. Over one third of all believers from Jesus' day until now have given their hearts to Christ in the last 40 years. Eighty percent of the new believers have come through the Pentecostal charismatic movement. This is powerfully true in Latin America, Africa, and Asia. Professor Yeoh of Purdue University says that by 2026 there will be 180 million believers in China, and by the year 2050 there will be 600 million believers! China will be the largest Christian nation on earth!

You are part of the greatest Christian thrust since the first century A.D. God has chosen you for such a time as this! I know you graduates of BCBM may feel very inadequate as you face the challenges of the future. Though you have received some of the finest in Pentecostal education through your dedicated and qualified faculty, still the task ahead seems awesome. Learn to trust the Lord. Take one step at a time. Keep faithful. The Spirit leads. God knows what He is doing. Someone once said, "The Spirit of God will set led you where the grace of God cannot keep you." The Spirit-led life is an amazing adventure!

I myself am amazed at how the Spirit led me — a shy, somewhat introverted boy from a pre-believing family — to take steps of obedience, to dare to glorify God. I have discovered the Spirit wants to do His work in me and through me. Over the years I have seen in ministry beyond my comprehension and scope served, and yet, through it all, I could not claim any of the glory. I didn't do it. I was just available. The Holy Spirit did the work. And you will find the same thing true in your life. It is not by seeking position, or fame. It is by being available.

You are called to be a vessel of the Holy Spirit. As you faithfully serve Christ, you will see these blessed, miraculous happenings, doors opening, relationships built, and souls saved. Your significance will be that you are part of the greatest partnership in the world — working together with the Holy Spirit to bring in the world this harvest, to build His Church, and to be Christ's ambassadors! Your effectiveness will be that you allowed the Spirit to work in you and through you. You will be enabled and empowered by the Holy Spirit to do things you could not do by your own strength.

All discover that, Biblically, a servant of God is the highest designation Higher than Apostle or King or Prophet or Priest. Moses, David, etc., and Jesus Himself declared themselves to be servants of God. As servants, you inherit the Hebrew 11 Lesser Pot of faith. You are in the mighty harvest. Some of you will minister in tough areas, sick results. Some will minister in ripe, ready for harvested areas. Paul water, but God gives the increases. Some of you may be persecuted out of the spiritual workers that inevitably comes with spiritualness. Be in knowing that God will use that for His glory.

For two weeks, 47 students who attended the Deuteronomy class were privileged to study under Rev. Dr. Edward J. Woods, one of Australia's prominent Old Testament scholars. He pursued his post-graduate studies at Oxford University and Oxford University in UK, and received his doctorate in Biblical Studies from the University of South Africa. Dr. Woods presently teaches part-time at the Melbourne School of Theology and has been a moderator for the Australian College of Theology in Old Testament. He also authored a commentary on Deuteronomy for the Tyndale Old Testament Commentary series (InterVarsity Press, 2011).

For many in the class, understanding Deuteronomy has resulted in an enriched love for God and a greater appreciation for His Law. Seeing the Deuteronomy's influence throughout the Bible from Genesis to Revelation enhances the preaching of God's Word. Often called the "book on the boundary" because it addresses the Israelites entering the Promised Land, Deuteronomy's importance is also further illustrated by the fact that Jesus quoted from Deuteronomy to rebuke the chief and best Paul frequently referenced Deuteronomy in his letters.
