





The theme chosen for this year's graduation is "Builders - Rebuilding of lives," based on the scripture text in Isaiah 58:12: "Your people will rebuild the ancient ruins and will raise up the age-old foundations; you will be called Repairer of Broken Walls, Restorer of Streets with Dwellings." The prophet might be here referring to Jerusalem and the cities, towns and villages of Judea which were destroyed by the Babylonians in 587 BC. The people were painfully aware that it was their sin and not the might of the invaders that was the cause of that tragic and unforgettable event. The prophet's message is that it will be their righteousness through the grace of God that will rebuild the city. He is not referring to just their personal religion and morality, but more directly to social justice; not exploiting their workers (v.3), not having guarrelling and strife and fighting among themselves (v.4), but loosing the chains of injustice (v.6), feeding the hungry, sheltering the homeless, and clothing the naked (v.7).

Isaiah's message is very pertinent to us today. As a nation, we are going through a very difficult time. Rampant corruption, racial strife, religious intolerance, declining economy, bad leadership - these are some of the words that aptly describe our nation. As a result, the church has been called to prayer and fasting which is most necessary. However there is another dimension that must not be neglected and it is this: the church and its people must let its light shine before the nation and therefore make a difference (Matthew 5:14-15). We must also be the salt of the earth.

The nation of Israel would be restored by the gentle insistence of God's grace and through the faithful ministries of his prophets and leaders such as Haggai, Zechariah, Zerubbabel, Joshua, Ezra, Nehemiah, and Malachi.

Today, we need such men and women who would answer the call of God to be rebuilders of lives and restorers of cities in this time of national crisis. It is my fervent hope and prayer that the graduating class of 2015 will join the company of prophets and leaders and be instruments of transformation, renewal and rebuilding by the grace of God.

(一) 重建祷告的祭坛

祷告是生活和事奉的优先选择。灵修、敬拜赞美、感恩、祷 告及代祷是传道人每天不可或缺的属灵操练。毁坏或失修的 祷告祭坛一旦重建起来,传道人在主里必重新得力。

(二) 重建生命的品格

品格和态度是一位传道人在事奉上成败的主因。因此,品格 及生命的塑造是一生的学习。生命和事奉的素质需要不断被 提升,这当中包括了人际关系的处理及沟通的技能。

(三) 重建事奉的理念

清楚事奉的哲理,能使传道人的事奉更有方向、目标及使命 感。一旦事奉的理念摆正了,事奉的方针和策略就不会偏离 当初所领受的异象和使命,并能常保自己走在事奉的正途

(四) 重建神学的思维

以利亚在神的山,即何烈山,因听见从神而来那把微小的声 音,心身灵重新得力,再次领受从神而来的异象和使命。此 后,他为三个人物膏抹,替他们立位,即膏抹哈薛作亚兰 王, 耶户作以色列王, 以及他的接棒人以利沙作先知(列王纪 上19:8-16)。可见一位参与铸造生命的人,只要自己先愿意 不断重整个人的生命,他的事奉也将更有能力地建设他人的 生命。

But he knew for sure that as long as he was alive, he would serve Christ and ensure Christ is magnified in everything that he does to repair and restore. Let us imitate Paul who imitated Christ, to remain humble and not take the glory that Christ alone deserves.
- Spirit-led: May the Holy Spirit lead you to marginalized communities that you have never dreamt of, places and nations that you dare not even think of. When it is led by Him, you will see fruits. Not by might, not by power but by His Spirit is not just lip-service; it is REAL if you allow yourself to walk in partnership with Him.

Certainly, the Light of the Lord will break forth and the revival of God will be evident in your ministries as you abide in Him and Him in you. True restoration demonstrates God's love and grace. My prayers go with each of you as you launch out as builders of His kingdom.





Sailing with the Corinthians A BCM night class experience

Course: 1st Corinthians Date: 21 July 2015 By: Neo Soon Siak

The eager thirty plus of us waited for the first Corinthians evening class to start at 7pm. We heard that we were having a Western lecturer, who had a wealth of ministry experience. Rev. Dr. Derek Newton had been a missionary to Indonesia where he ministered with his family for ten years. He had also spent many years in Manila as the New Testament Lecturer and the Dean of Faculty, and interestingly, even worked in Malaysia for some time during his early years. Added to his scholarly experience, he had served as the Head of the Master of Theology programme in Biblical interpretation at a Scottish Bible School. Naturally, I counted myself to be privileged to be taught by a man of such academic standing.

During our course, Dr. Newton would occasionally check with us if we were able to follow his lectures. His consideration for us could be seen further in all his course reading materials, which were not only readable but mercifully brief – 3 pages long at most! He understood that evening class students were already loaded with their family, work and other commitments. Thus, the short notes would not be too overwhelming but easily completed to supplement the lessons taught.

Despite the absence of any PowerPoint slides in class, Dr. Newton held our attention throughout the lessons. The lessons were more than academic. The problems faced by the Apostle Paul were made relevant as the learned lecturer shared his related experiences in Indonesia, Manila, Scotland and Malaysia. Such learning experiences were priceless, and we were indeed privileged to sit at the feet of one who could dig deep into the Word of God and present precious gems to his students.

At one point in the course, Dr. Newton's beloved wife suffered a nasty accident and was hospitalised for a few days at the University Hospital. Despite his obvious concern and sadness, there was such a quiet confidence and peace evident in him as he continued the lectures with us. The Corinthians course was about God's glory and power seen in our weaknesses, and he was a living witness to His glory and power.

I was much blessed by this eleven-lesson course. Thank you, Dr Newton for the weeks of pouring out your wisdom, passion and experience on us!

Diploma in Ministerial Counseling

BCM launched the Diploma in Ministerial Counseling program in 2008, and as at 2014, we have seen 64 students complete their training to become effective counselors. This two-year program is designed to equip care-givers, Christian leaders and pastors to be more effective counselors by integrating personal

growth and professional development. The program incorporates theoretical reflection, understanding of issues and practical counseling skills, understanding of the self, group processes and theological reflection.

I am very thankful to the friend who recommended this course to me. I enrolled with the expectation of understanding people/human behavior more. However, I actually learnt to understand myself more.

I began this course with the right module, which was "The Human Story". It gave me a very clear picture of what Counselling is, and it gave me a sense of belonging and confidence about being a counselor. It is this sense of security which I will always hold sacred.

The assignments given were able to reinforce knowledge, stimulate thoughts and provide opportunity for discussion. We were exposed to plenty of resources. In fact, going through this course helped me to rediscover myself, see my own flaws as well as my potential, and to identify what is within my ability and what is beyond.

Not only has the course blessed me personally, it has also helped me rebuild my marriage, restructure my parenting/co-parenting skills and methods with my spouse. Most importantly, it has helped me understand counselling from a biblical view versus a secular worldview, and see how important it is to focus on God.

I told myself I had to complete this course no matter how long it would take with my busy schedule, not so much because I wanted the certificate, but simply because I needed the "message" GOD intended for me to discover through it. Indeed, my time in this course has been so precious and I believe God has led my path here.

His Direction, My Transformation

I started the Diploma in Counseling Studies with many issues in my world, both internally and externally. I grew up with much suffering and mistrust, as a result of rejections, disappointments, pain, fears and persecution from my own family and people. I was regarded as an apostate for accepting Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior and life was very difficult and full of struggles for me.

When I first received my call to undertake a study in counseling and a Bachelor of Theology at the Bible College of Malaysia, I asked the Lord many questions, such as "Why BCM? Why counseling? And why in Malaysia?" Well, what I did not know was that God had a better plan for my life. It was here I came to study under the able leadership of my lecturer, Prof. Rebecca Chong, who has been such a powerful instrument of God to bring a total change in my life, through her well-mastered, experienced spirit-filled and spirit-led teaching.

I personally came to understand how God was using these studies to heal and transform my life completely. Each step of the study plan and setting led me into facing my issues and to process them. These were personal issues that I had regressed and suppressed all these years. Additionally, these personal healings and transformations and my deeper relationship with my Creator has had a horizontal reflection or manifestation in my ministry, with my church members and the congregation as a whole.
