

Diploma in Ministerial Counseling

The counseling programs at BCM are designed to equip caregivers, Christian leaders and pastors to be more effective counselors by integrating Christian belief with personal growth and professional development. The Diploma in Ministerial Counseling will incorporate theoretical reflection, understanding of issues and practical counseling skills, understanding of the self, group processes and theological reflection. **Graduation requirement: 30 credits.**

ADMISSION CRITERIA

- Christian maturity
- Endorsement from church or pastor

PROGRAM STRUCTURE (30 CREDITS)

- A modular program with 10 courses (30 credits) that can be completed within 2.5 – 3 years.
- Each course is scheduled over 5-10 weeks and is held on weeknights (Mon-Fri)
- Time of Classes: from 7.00 pm – 10.00 pm
