

Graduate/Postgraduate Certificate in Ministerial Counseling

The Graduate/Postgraduate Certificate in Ministerial Counseling is designed to equip counselors and psychologists to be effective mental health practitioners by integrating Christian belief with personal growth and professional development. **Graduation requirement: 18 credits.**

There are two ministerial counseling specializations to choose from:

- Certificate in Trauma Healing
- Certificate in Marriage and Family Counseling

Courses incorporate theoretical reflection, understanding of mental health issues and the person of the counselor / psychologist. This program will take an estimated three years to complete.

Admission Requirements

- 1. Applicants must have at least one year of counseling or ministry experience
- 2. For the Graduate Certificate, applicants must hold a degree in counseling or psychology
- 3. For the Postgraduate Certificate, applicants must hold a master's degree in counseling or psychology
