

## Diploma of Christian Studies

---

The Diploma of Christian Studies is designed to meet the needs of lay leaders who desire a deeper level of training beyond the Certificate of Biblical Studies. **Graduation requirement: 60 credits.**

### Admission Requirements

1. Upon completion of 9 credits of course work, students are required to matriculate (i.e. be formally enrolled in the Diploma in Christian Studies program) in order to continue their studies. No further courses may be taken for credit without matriculation.
2. Three recommendations from the Senior Pastor/Chairman/Elder and two local church leaders respectively.
