The Bachelor of Theology program is designed for those intending to enter the full-time ministry as pastors, missionaries, Christian educators and church workers. **Graduation requirement: 120 credits.**

Admission Requirements

- 1. Applicants with a regular baccalaureate degree or its equivalent from an accredited institution may complete the Bachelor of Theology with 90 trimester credits.
- 2. Applicants with a Diploma of Theology from a Bible College with a grade point average of 2.5 can complete the Bachelor of Theology with an additional 36 credits.
