

Master of Divinity (General Track)

This program is designed to provide training in theological and ministerial studies at the graduate level for those who are preparing for Christian ministry. It also serves to prepare those desiring to further their theological education at the post graduate level. **Graduation requirement: 93 credits.**

Admission Requirements

- 1. Possess a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent from a recognized institution together with active ministry involvement and spiritual maturity.
- 2. Those with a Bachelor's degree from an accredited Bible College can complete the program with 66 credits of study.
- 3. Those with a Master of Ministry or equivalent from an accredited Bible College can complete the program with 33 credits of study.
