

## Master of Divinity (Ministry Track)

---

This program is designed to provide a graduate theological education for students who are preparing for ministry and leadership in the church. It focuses on foundational understandings and skills in preparation for pastoral leadership. **Graduation requirement: 93 credits.**

### Admission Requirements

1. Possess a baccalaureate degree or its equivalent from a recognized institution together with active ministry involvement and spiritual maturity.
2. Those with a bachelor's degree from an accredited Bible College can complete the program with 66 credits of study.
3. Those with a Master of Ministry or equivalent from an accredited Bible College can complete the program with 33 credits of study.
